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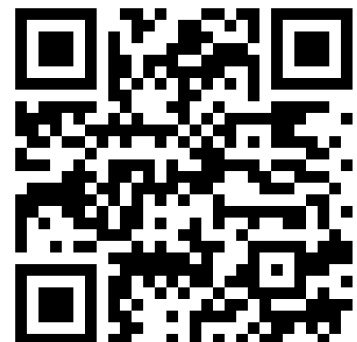
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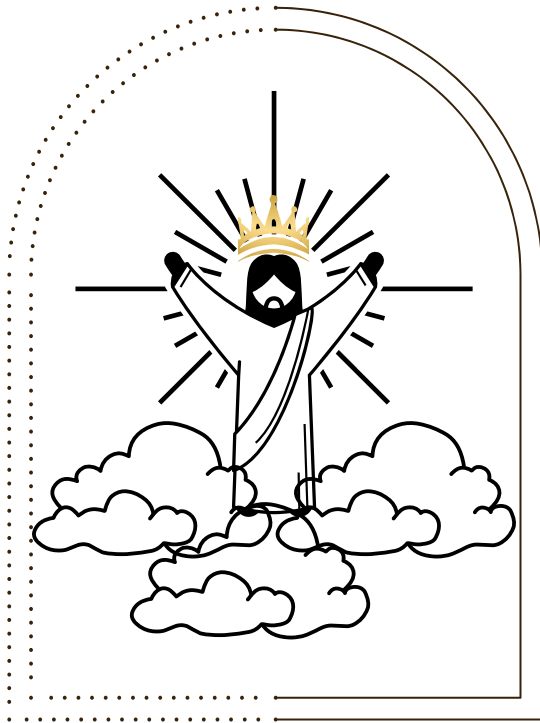

## WHAT IS HIS KINGDOM?

*Module 1*

### **WHO IS GOD?:**

The Word of God in Deuteronomy 6:4-5 says, *Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.*

What is God?

*God is a Spirit: God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth. John 4:24*

*God is the Word: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John 1:1*

*God is love: He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. 1 John 4:8.*

### **JESUS IS KING:**

The One True God appeared to man on earth in a human body, the body of Jesus Christ. (Read 1 Tim. 3:16).

*The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be. Genesis 49:10*

*Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre. Psalms 45:6 (See also Hebrews 1:8-9).*

*Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, be honour and glory forever and ever. Amen. 1 Tim. 1:17*

## **WHERE IS HIS KINGDOM?:**

The Pharisees demanded that Jesus tell them when the Kingdom of God should come. The gospels are filled with people waiting for the Kingdom of God. They had their ideas of what it would look like. Jesus answers the Pharisees with this: *...The kingdom of God cometh not with observation: Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.* Luke 17:20-21. Jesus gave them a clue about where the Kingdom of God would be. They were expecting to see a physical kingdom established on earth, but Jesus' kingdom is a spiritual Kingdom. You wouldn't be able to look on a map and say, Oh, here it is!

The Pharisee, Nicodemus, came secretly by night to Jesus. He began to say how he believed he was from God and praised Him. Jesus said to Nicodemus: *...Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.* John 3:3. Nicodemus is so confused! How can someone be born again when he is old? You cannot even see the Kingdom of God without being born again! Jesus tells him what he must do. *...Verily, Verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.* John 3:5

Jesus told the Pharisee the location of the Kingdom of God: within you. The Kingdom of God is on the inside of us! Jesus told Nicodemus that to see the Kingdom of God, he had to be born again. As Nicodemus questioned Him more, Jesus told him, you must be born of the water, meaning you must be baptized and you must be born of the Spirit, or filled with the Holy Spirit.

## **WHAT IS THE KINGDOM OF GOD?:**

*For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.* Romans 14:17

Again, the Kingdom of God isn't something physical that you could see with the natural eye, and it's not something that you eat or drink. The Kingdom of God is righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost. In Jesus' Kingdom, we have righteousness, peace, and joy.

In God's Kingdom, He is on the throne of our hearts. He rules and reigns, meaning nothing else takes His place in our hearts and no enemy can have power over us. We put Him and His will or His desires above everything else. Because we put Him first, and don't worry about ourselves, our needs are taken care of. He knows what we need before we ask.

*Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.* Matthew 6:31-33.

God wants to give you His Kingdom and He wants you to help others have it too! *Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.* Luke 12:32.

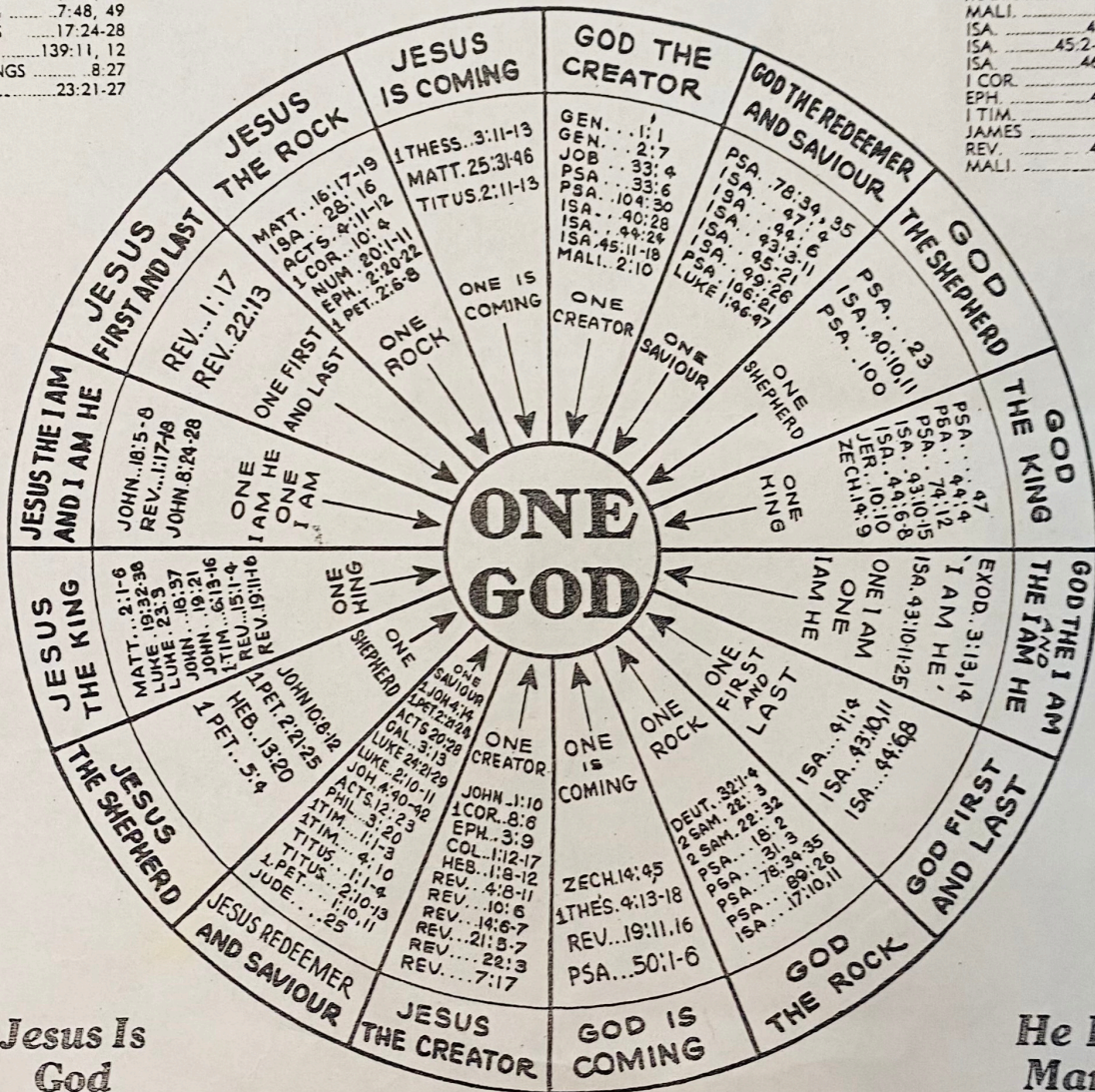

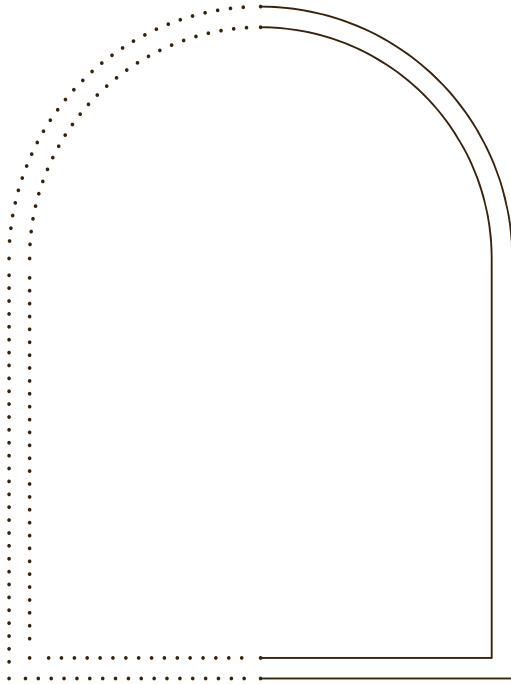

Our relationship with our Heavenly Father is the most wonderful thing on earth. Not only is our Father a King who owns everything but, He is always available, always present, and willing to listen. He's not afraid of anything; He's stronger than anyone. He does everything the best! He is love - not just loving - He is love. He's patient, kind, not proud, and doesn't like evil or bad stuff, He is always good, always cares for you, and doesn't keep a record of our wrongs. He is ever faithful, never leaves you, and doesn't give up on you. He always gives you the right advice and brings peace in the storm. These are just a few of the things our Father, the King is. He is so much more! What about you? Who do people say that you are? Maybe you have been hurt by what others have said about you. The good thing is that since God made you and He does everything well; you have a unique purpose and design. Who does God say you are? Write it up in the box so you can remember. His opinion is the one that matters! He has many good things to say about you, and you can find them in His word! He tells us in His word that this is how He feels about us:

**YOU'RE THE APPLE OF HIS EYE:**

*For thus saith the Lord of hosts; After the glory hath he sent me unto the nations which spoiled you: for he that toucheth you toucheth the apple of his eye. Zechariah 2:8*

**YOU'RE BEAUTIFUL AND WONDERFULLY MADE:**

*Thou art beautiful, O my love, as Tirzah, comely as Jerusalem, terrible as an army with banners. Song of Solomon 6:4*

*I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well. Psalm 139:14*

**YOU ARE HIS CHILD:**

*For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. Romans 8:14*

*And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty. 2 Corinthians 6:18*

*Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not. Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. 1 John 3:1-2*

### **YOU ARE HIS DELIGHT:**

*Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles. Isaiah 42:1*

*The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the Lord: but the prayer of the upright is his delight. Proverbs 15:8*

*He brought me forth also into a large place: he delivered me, because he delighted in me. 2 Samuel 22:20*

*But to the saints that are in the earth, and to the excellent, in whom is all my delight. Psalm 16:3*

### **HIS SOLDIER:**

*Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier. 2 Timothy 2:3-4*

Wow! Jesus is crazy about you! You are very precious to Him!!

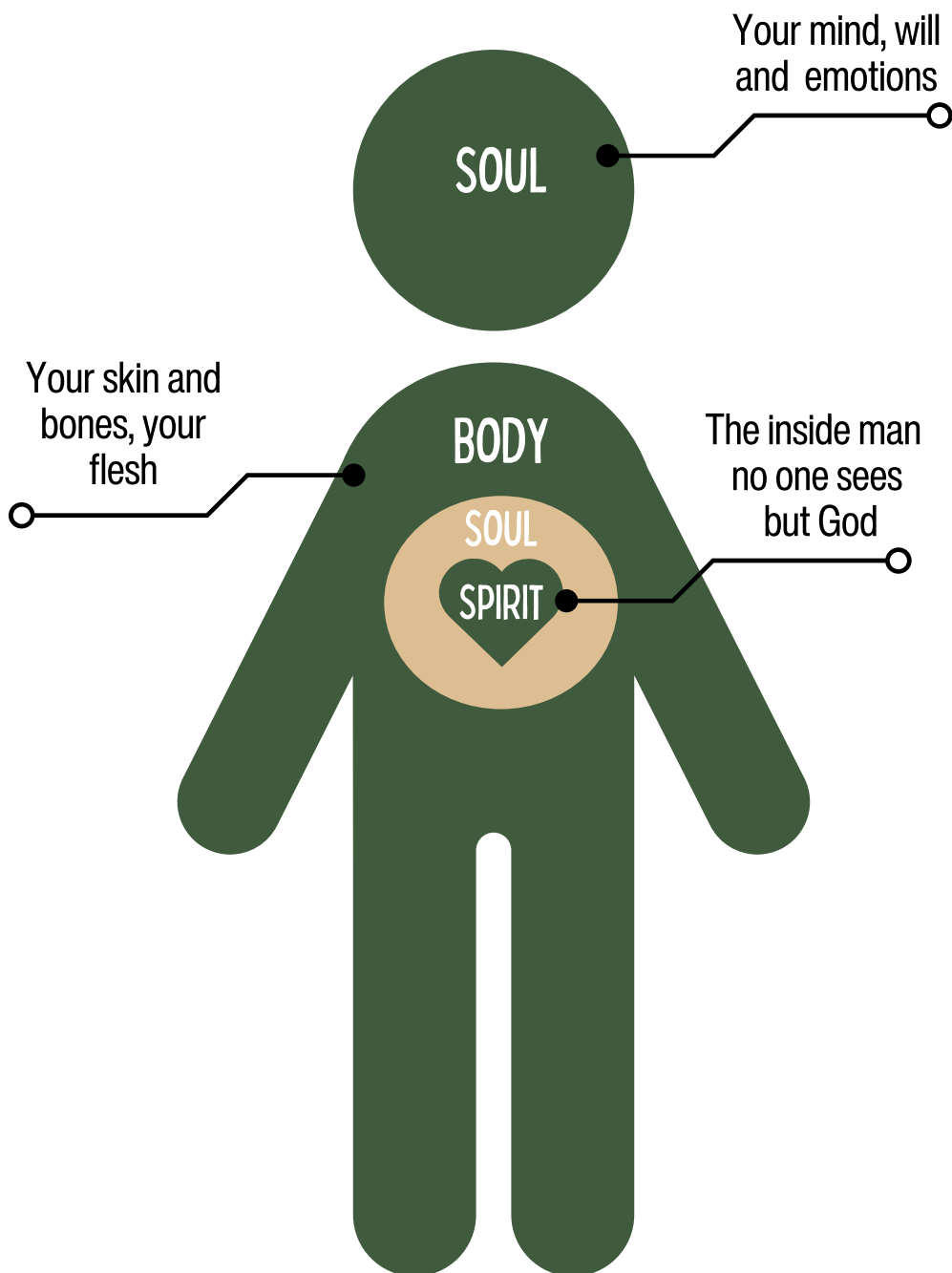
God desires a close personal relationship with you. Just like a best friend! When we repent, get baptized in Jesus name, and are filled with the Holy Ghost we have begun a new life with Him! All our sins are washed away and we can come with boldness into the throne room of God. Think for a moment about your relationships. If you wanted something from your parents you would have to talk to them. If you spend time with them, you find out how much they love you. With your parents or friends the more time you spend with them the more you find out what they like and don't like. When you love your parents, you want to please them and make them happy. You want to obey them. It is the same with the Lord. When we love Him so much we want to spend time with Him and obey Him. Think about your dad going to build a home for you. He wants to make sure that the foundation is strong and secure and that nothing will make it fall down. He spends time preparing and building it just right. It's the same for our relationship with Him. We must take time to prepare and be trained by Him. The word of God says we are His temple. We are His building. We are the place that He desires His Spirit to live in.

Once we have obeyed Acts 2:38, we are living Kingdom and under His Lordship! We are under the authority and protection of the King. He is our Commander-in-chief! There is much to learn in His Kingdom. Are you ready to learn His ways? Let's go!

*After this manner therefore pray ye:  
Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.  
Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread.  
And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.  
And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil:  
For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.  
Matthew 6:9-13*

In the passage on the previous page, Jesus said, After this manner, pray. He was not saying to repeat these words, and your prayers are done. He was saying this was a guide. Our prayers should be after this pattern. God's Kingdom is a spiritual kingdom. The Bible tells us that we are made up of spirit, soul and body. We have a spirit, the person on the inside no one sees (but God does), we have a soul, that's our mind, our will and our emotions and we have a body. That's the skin and bones that everyone sees. So in King Jesus's kingdom we see, hear, smell and feel with our spiritual senses. You can be thinking and feeling things that no one sees but God.

You are a world-changer for God's kingdom! Children have 2 main jobs in the Kingdom of God. We will be talking about two of them in this material quite a bit. Job number 1 is to love and obey. Job number 2 is to praise Jesus. We will be looking at the Word to help us.





# SHOUT FOR THE VICTORY!

## Module 3

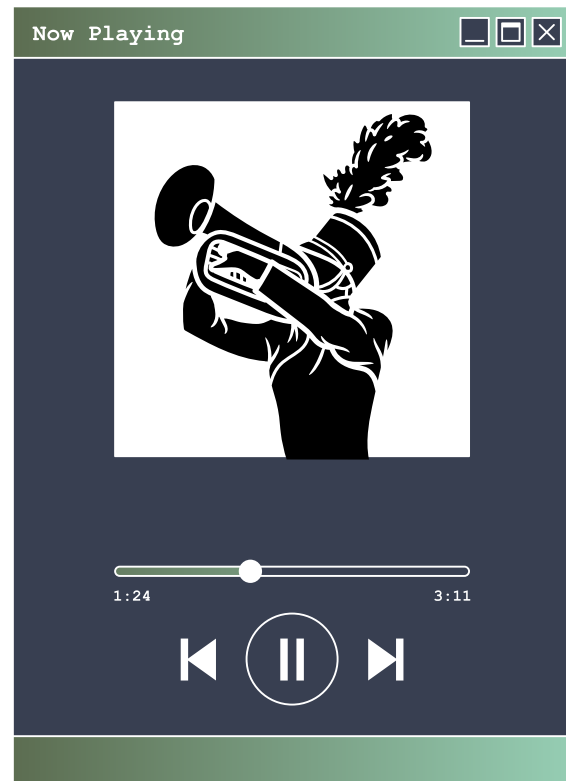
Praise is a powerful weapon against our enemy!

*"Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name." Psalm 100:4*

*"Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightest still the enemy and the avenger." Psalm 8:2*

*"And David danced before the Lord with all his might; and David was girded with a linen ephod." 2 Samuel 6:14*

*"Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power. Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness. Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp. Praise him with the timbrel and dance: praise him with stringed instruments and organs. Praise him upon the loud cymbals. Let everything that hath breath praise the Lord. Praise ye the LORD." Psalm 150*



Think about the story of Samuel. His momma prayed for him and wanted to have him so bad! God granted her the desire of her heart, and she gave birth to a baby boy and dedicated him to the Lord. Hannah might have had a short time to prepare her son to live for the Lord, but when she takes him to the house of God and presents him to Eli to serve in the house of the Lord, the Bible says: *"And he worshipped the Lord there."* (1 Sam. 1:28). Not only did he know to worship the Lord when he was brought to the temple, he knew and understood how to obey and respect God and the man of God in his life. Did Hannah teach Samuel a fear of the Lord, and to respect the man of God? I think she was a woman of integrity because when she was given a son, she *"lent him to the Lord, as long as he liveth he shall be lent to the Lord."* Samuel was mightily used by God.



### TO STUDY:

KEY VERSES: PSALM 8:2, MATT. 21:16, LUKE 10:27, MATTHEW 26:6-13, MARK 14:3-9,  
LUKE 7:36-50, ACTS 15:15-17

Samuel grew up a mighty man of God, and none of his words would fall to the ground thanks to his father's prophetic prayer over him. It was Samuel who anointed David - one of the most mighty worshipping warriors recorded in scripture. We know the Lord said David was "a man after God's own heart." David's passion for worship and his faithfulness to practice and serve made him the mighty man he became. Anointing is important - it comes from the Lord. However, training and discipline are our part. David was not ashamed to worship - he danced before the Lord with all his might. He was passionate about the Lord. We must show our passion for the Lord and demonstrate it, too. Whatever David did, whether singing, dancing, blessing with his mouth, or giving, he did it with great passion for the Lord. God prophesied that He would build again the tabernacle of David. The tabernacle of David was filled with worshipping young people who prophesied!



Did you know, the great prophet Samuel was actually a descendant of Korah (seven generations later, we see Samuel appear in the genealogy). Korah, unfortunately, had rebellion and died, but Numbers 26:11 lets us know that the children of Korah died not. What was the Korahites' job in the temple?

Read 1 Chronicles 9:19-31. Samuel's descendants were gatekeepers, and they were responsible for things that were made in the pans. (Lev. 6:21). They were to guard the temple and minister to the Lord by preparing sacrifices. Now we are the temple of the Holy Ghost! Our praise and worship is our sacrifice.

*By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.* Hebrews 13:15

Jesus gives us a clue on how to approach Him:

*Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.* Psalm 100:4



**LIKE DAVID, WE WILL GIVE OUR ALL IN WORSHIP, AND LIKE SAMUEL'S FAMILY, WE ARE GATEKEEPING SOLDIERS - ENTERING IN TO HIS PRESENCE WITH PRAISE AND THANKSGIVING!**

As a soldier in the Lord's Army, you are also a gatekeeper. It matters what you let in and out of your gates. Your eyes, ears, nose, and feelings are a gate. If you let bad music in, you will start to feel those emotions. God is looking at our inner man. How do I feel about God on the inside? When I love Him, I can't hide it. Luke 10:27 tells us how we need to love Him with our heart (Jesus help me to love You the way I am supposed to love You - give me a heart that loves you), our souls (our emotions, will, like decisions we make - Jesus help my emotions to only be moved by Your Spirit), our mind (how we think about Him - Jesus give me Your thoughts), our strength (our ability, what we possess like talents, money - Jesus use my hands for Your purpose). The woman with the alabaster box didn't care who saw her radical worship. When you get the Holy Ghost, it helps you to be full of that love that God has.



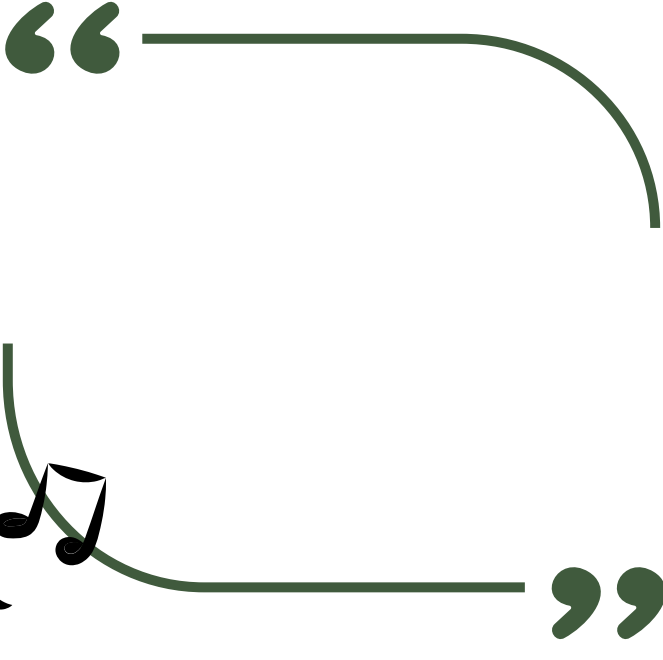
**READ OR DO A SKIT:**

# ARMOR OF GOD

## Module 4

*But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief. Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness. Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober. For they that sleep sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night. But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. 1 Thessalonians 5:4-8*

*Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; Ephesians 6:11-18*

### HELMET:

I have the mind of Christ. Protect my eyes, ears and mind. I cast down imaginations and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God and bring it into captivity, making them obedient to Christ.

### BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS:

Protect my heart and emotions. Let them only be moved by Your Spirit. Help me not to be easily offended.

### BELT OF TRUTH:

Your Spirit guides me into all truth. Don't let me be deceived. Let Your Spirit and Word guide my every step. Keep my tongue from evil and my lips from speaking guile. Let me speak the truth to my own hurt and always in love.

### SHOES OF GOSPEL OF PEACE:

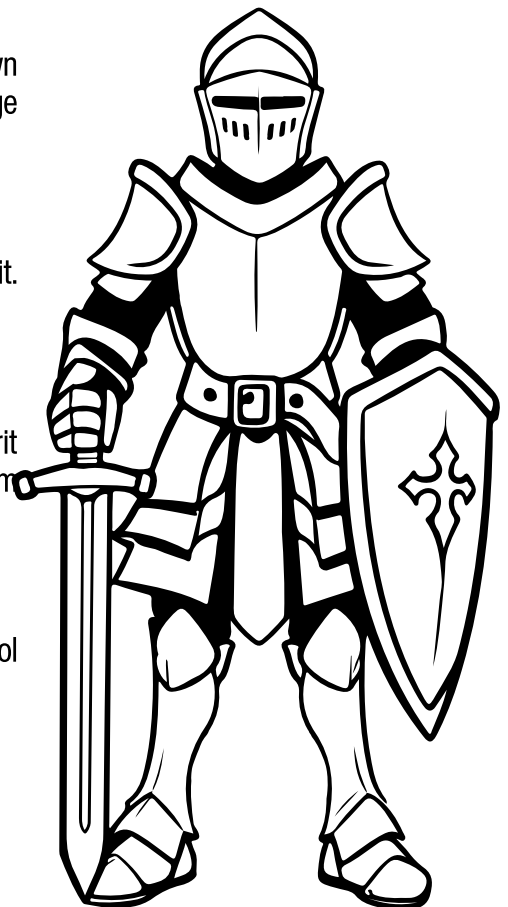
Give me boldness to declare the gospel and peace upon my home, school and everywhere I go.

### SHIELD OF FAITH:

I have the faith of Christ, by it I will quench all the fiery darts of the enemy.

### SWORD OF THE SPIRIT:

The sword of the Spirit is the Word of God. Let it be of deadly force against the enemy.



# LISTENING

Jesus desires to speak to you. Ask God to give you eyes to see and ears to hear what He has to say to you. In the Bible, the boy Samuel learned to hear the voice of God. He said, "Speak, for thy servant heareth..." God may speak to you with pictures in your mind or words you may hear in your spirit. You may get feelings. In this section, we want to practice being sensitive to those impressions. Now, let's go deeper and get to know Jesus more!\*

# THE KING'S REQUEST



**READ MATTHEW 9:37-38 OR LUKE 10:2 JESUS ASKED THAT WE PRAY THAT THE LORD OF THE HARVEST WOULD SEND FORTH LABORERS INTO THE HARVEST.**

In the word of God, Jesus looked on the multitudes and turned to the disciples and told them that the harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few. He told them to pray the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest. This was a direct request from Jesus. He saw that people were fainting. They were as sheep having no shepherd. There was no one to guide and disciple them. He was going everywhere in every city, living out the Word of God. He was preaching the gospel, healing every sickness and every disease. We can pray for laborers and for God's harvest of souls. God compared peoples hearts and souls to different kinds of soil.

READ Matthew 13:3-9, or Mark 4:1-9, or Luke 8:4-8

*A sower went forth to sow...*

*(The seed is the Word of God - Luke 8:11.)*

Some seed fell by the **wayside**, fowls devoured them up...

*(Wayside soil heard it but immediately Satan comes and takes away what was sown in their heart - Mark.4:15.)*

Some fell on **stony** places, not much earth, sun scorches them, no root, withers away.

*The rocky soil hear and receive with joy but because of no roots, when persecution or temptation comes they get offended and fall away. - Luke 8:13.)*

Some fell among **thorns**; and the thorns sprung up and choked them.

*They hear but then the cares of this world, the deceitfulness of riches and the lusts of other things choke the good seed and they become unfruitful. -Mark 4:19.*



*But other fell into good ground, and brought forth fruit, some an hundredfold, some sixtyfold, some thirtyfold. (The good ground hears the word, understands it, bears fruit, an hundredfold, sixty or thirty. - Matthew 13:23.)*

The “fruit” is both the good fruits that come from having the Spirit and the Word of God in your life and it is also the disciples you will make as you share the word with others.

My family lives on about four acres. My husband’s favorite thing to plant is watermelon. The watermelon grows best in the ashes from the burn pile. Sometimes he just throws it on the ground to see if it will grow. The burn pile is the best place to grow it because all the things that would make the soil not good for the seed is burned out and the ashes give the soil a rich amount of carbon where the watermelon will grow faster and better. We may plant one seed but when the watermelon is fully grown it will produce a fruit that may have a hundred other seeds inside.

*Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit. - John 12:24*

If we never planted the seed, it would only remain as one seed. But if we plant it in good soil, water it, it will produce fruit that has 100 more seeds in it! We save the seeds and replant them next year. In this way, we always have fruit to eat.



Jesus - water the soil, send your Spirit! (John 7:38)

Jesus - prepare the soil for the word and let it fall on good ground! (Hosea 10:12)

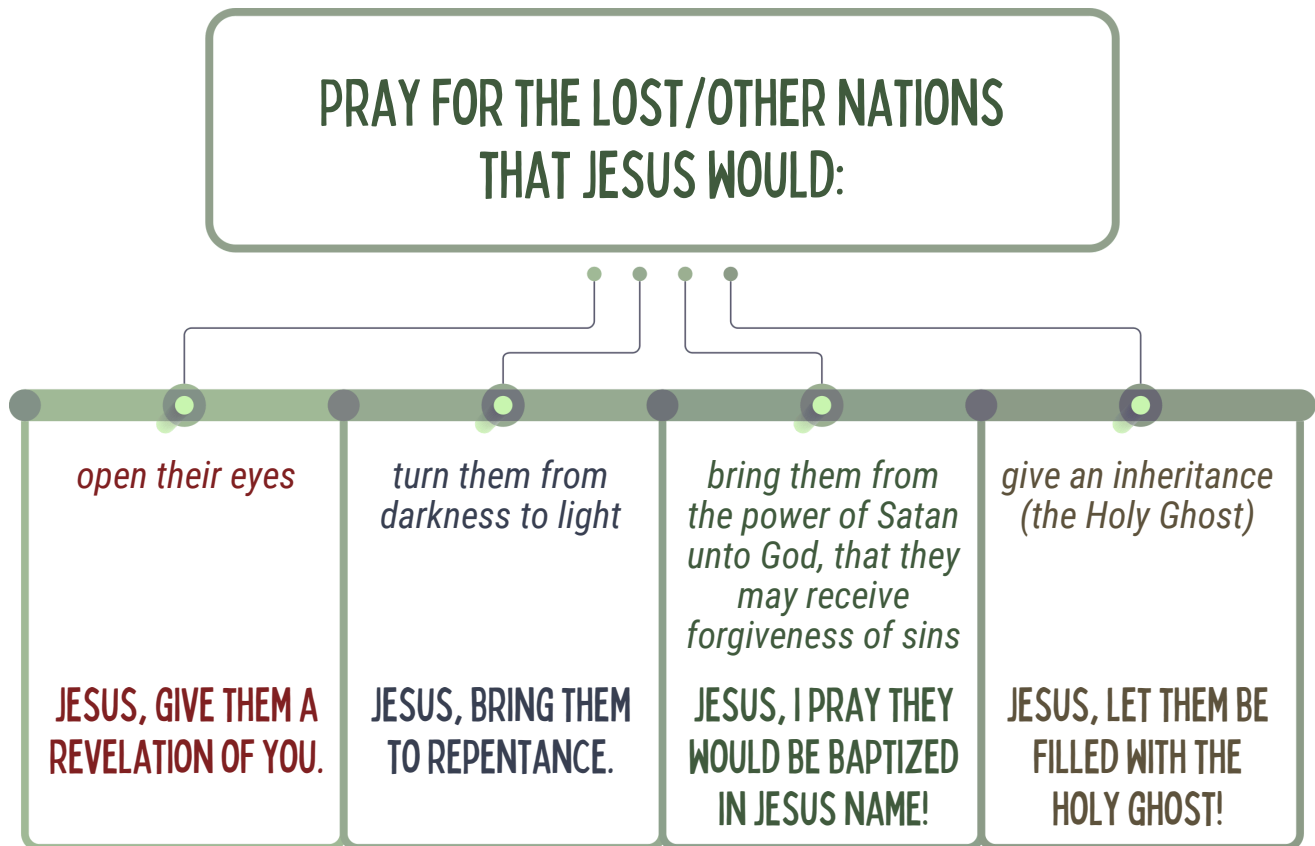
Jesus - let their hearts be rooted and grounded in YOUR love! (Eph. 3:17-18)

# INTERCESSION

1 Samuel 12:23-24 *Moreover as for me, God forbid that I should sin against the Lord in ceasing to pray for you: but I will teach you the good and the right way: Only fear the Lord, and serve him in truth with all your heart: for consider how great things he hath done for you.*

Samuel was a man of prayer. He teaches us that it is a sin for us to cease to pray. Praying and interceding for others is something God wants all of us to do.

I like to use this verse to pray for those that are lost. We can impact nations with this prayer out of this one verse: Acts 26:18 - *To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.*



# HEALING

When Jesus prayed for those who were sick, he commanded the sickness to leave their body. We can be used in God's Kingdom to pray for the sick!

*"Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father."* John 14:12

We can use the **LABB** Method found in 7 Essentials of Kids Prayer 2.0: Reflecting God's Glory. (Clark, 2012, p 91-92).

**LABB** is an acronym for:

**Listen:**

See if the Holy Ghost directs you to pray for someone, see if you hear anyone, or discern that anyone needs prayer for healing.

**Ask:**

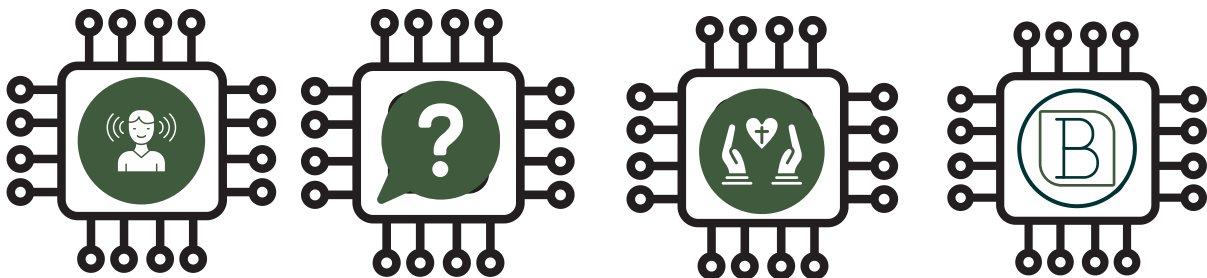
Ask them if they want prayer.

**Build faith:**

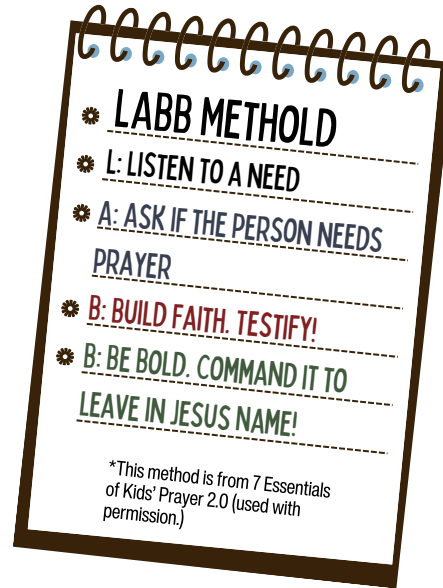
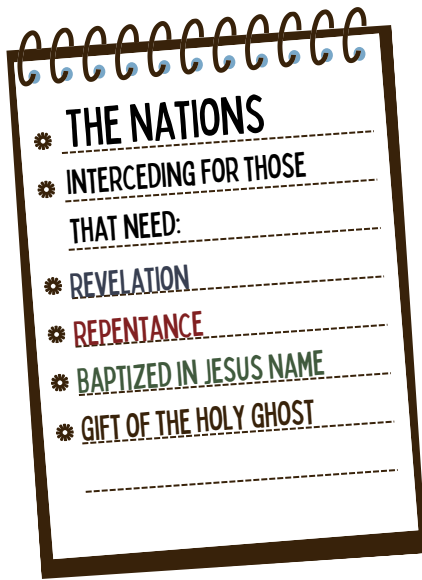
Testify how the Lord has done healing works in your life or those you know.

# REPENT! ABOUT FACE! CLEAN OUT THE BARRACKS!

## Module 5

We will begin by learning how to guard our temple and keep it clean. Remember we are gatekeepers just like Samuel's family. We let the right stuff in and keep the wrong stuff out! When we are in the Lord's Army we must keep our temple clean every day! The Holy Ghost will convict our hearts of things that are displeasing to Him. With the help of the Lord, we are going to clean out our barracks. Barracks are where soldiers stay during training. Our barracks are our temples or our spirits on the inside. It's like our attitudes or things we think about. We are going to repent of anything that doesn't belong there. When the commander yells REPENT the soldiers must turn around and walk the opposite direction! Remember asking for forgiveness is different from repentance.

2 Corinthians 7:10-11 - *For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death. For behold this selfsame thing, that ye sorrowed after a godly sort, what carefulness it wrought in you, yea, what clearing of yourselves, yea, what indignation, yea, what fear, yea, what vehement desire, yea, what zeal, yea, what revenge! In all things ye have approved yourselves to be clear in this matter.*

## STEPS OF REPENTANCE:

STEP 1:

### RESPOND TO THE NUDGING OF THE HOLY GHOST

You know when you start feeling bad about something you were thinking, going to do, or did do?

STEP 2:

### LISTEN TO THE HOLY GHOST AND STOP FIGHTING (THOUGHTS, WORDS OR ACTIONS) /YIELDING TO WRONG

Sometimes we are fighting the authorities in our lives that are trying to help us. Sometimes we fight God or even ourselves by thinking or acting in a bad way:

*Only by pride cometh contention: but with the well advised is wisdom.* Proverbs 13:10

*I hearkened and heard, but they spake not aright: no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? every one turned to his course, as the horse rusheth into the battle.* Jeremiah 8:6

*Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge.* James 4:11

# STEPS OF REPENTANCE:

## STEP 3: CONFESS

*Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.* Psalm 139:23-24

*Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me.* Psalm 51:2-3

*Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.* Psalm 51:10

*He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.* Proverbs 28:13

*If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.* 1 John 1:9

## STEP 4: ASK FOR FORGIVENESS

Jesus forgive me for \_\_\_\_\_. He's loving and faithful. He forgives and forgets.

*If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.* 2 Chronicles 7:14

*In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;* Ephesians 1:7

*Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy. ## STEP 5: YIELD TO GOD

Humble yourself - choose to walk His right path, to repent, to turn away from it and not to yield to it again.

# HOW TO ADDRESS SUPERIORS: PRAYING FOR AUTHORITY

## Module 6

God uses loving discipline to help us stay on the right path. He has placed authority in our life to guide and discipline us. What is an authority? From Oxford languages, authority is the power or right to give orders, make decisions, and enforce obedience. Who are our authorities? Our Pastor, church leaders, parents, grandparents, teachers, and police officers. As the King's kids, we must learn to humble ourselves and love, honor, obey, and thank God for them.

*But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded. Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge. James 4:6-11*

*Blessed is the man whom you discipline, O Lord, and whom you teach out of your law, Psalm 94:12*

*My son, do not despise the Lord's discipline or be weary of his reproof, for the Lord reproves him whom he loves, as a father the son in whom he delights. Proverbs 3:11-12*

*Whoever spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is diligent to discipline him. Proverbs 13:24, ESV*

*Discipline your son, for there is hope; do not set your heart on putting him to death. Proverbs 19:18, ESV*

*And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by him. For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives." It is for discipline that you have to endure. God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline? For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it. Hebrews 12:5-7, 11, ESV*

*Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent. Revelation 3:19, ESV*

*Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give an account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you. Hebrews 13:17*

*Children, obey your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord. Colossians 3:20*

*Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, Titus 3:1*

*Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation. Romans 13:1-2*

# GIDEON BREAKS STRIFE (FIGHTING)

Remember that we do not fight people. A lesson that the King's kids must learn is how to overcome the real enemy - the devil. Remember the story of Adam and Eve? Eve was listening to the wrong voice. The serpent tricked her and lied to her. We must learn how to listen to Jesus. I want to tell you a story of a brave young man who stood for righteousness and saved an entire nation.

Remember the story of Gideon. How the people feared the gods of the Amorites (Judges 6:10) instead of listening to the voice of God and the Midianites (strife) moved in. The people turned to idolatry and their harvest was stolen. If we disobey God, the enemy will offer us an idol. If there is something we have put in the place of God or take matters into our own hands, we begin to deal with strife. Realize that the enemy will stir up rebellion by pushing disunity or will cause you to question authorities in your life. God ALWAYS deals with his authority. If we get offended it means we are not trusting God. If we are listening to the wrong voice it can plant seeds of rebellion as well.

Gideon broke strife not by fist-fighting his way with people and beating up all the others but by worship, praise (trumpet), humility (breaking the pitcher), and exalting light - revelation- the way God sees things or the person (holding up the lamp).



Breaking pitchers - we are the pitchers:

*The precious sons of Zion, comparable to fine gold, how are they esteemed as earthen pitchers, the work of the hands of the potter! Lamentations 4:2*

*But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us. 2 Corinthians 4:7*

When you listen to bitter accusations from the enemy it brings strife, accusations, and fighting. And now there was no fruitfulness so Israel turned to Baal a false God- a fertility god thinking that would make them fruitful. But it took a man of God who was obedient to the Lord to tear down the idol and then he was able to defeat Midian with the sword of the Lord...what is the sword of the Lord? The word of God! Gideon helps us to see how to break rebellion/disunity against authority or others and build a wall of protection against it:

*I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. 1 Timothy 2:1-2*

*Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby. Hebrews 12:11*

# HOW DO WE BREAK IT?

- 1 Praise and thank God for the leaders in our life.
- 2 Humble ourselves by telling the Lord we don't want to have things our way but we want to obey Him and our leaders/parents, etc. (Do James 4:7-9.)
- 3 Ask God to show us the light - help us see others the way He sees them. Ask God to help you to love them the way you should.
- 4 Pray for your Pastor, parents, and other leaders in your life. Pray that God would bless them spiritually, lead them and guide them in wisdom and understanding, pray for their health and that God would bless them in their finances.
- 5 Obey! Do what they say. Look ways you can serve them.

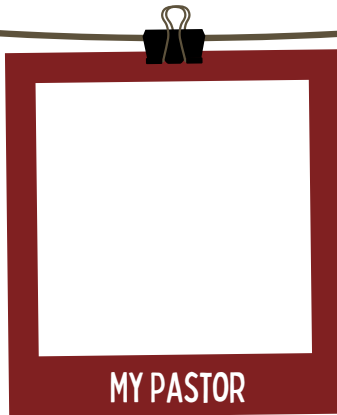
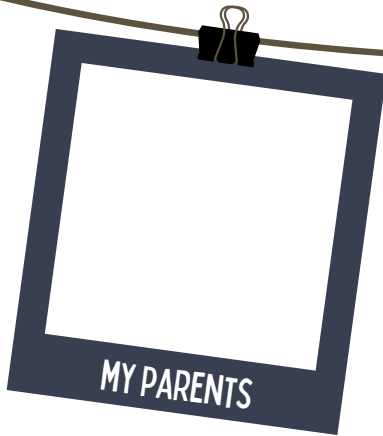

# LEARNING FORGIVENESS

## Module 7

Jesus taught us that offenses would come. People may do and say things that hurt us. But He also taught us to forgive them as He has forgiven us.

We all have sinned and everyone has done wrong.

*For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Romans 3:23*

Think like Jesus! God forgave us of all the bad stuff in our lives and He tells us to do the same for others and ourselves.

*Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. Colossians 3:13*

*For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. Matthew 6:14-15*

If we do not forgive then we block the Lord from forgiving us. We then struggle. The Bible instructs us to bless those that curse us and hate us:

*Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not. Romans 12:14*

*Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men. If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men. Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord. Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head. Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good. Romans 12:17-21*

*But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which hate you, Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you. And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise. For if ye love them which love you, what thank have ye? for sinners also love those that love them. And if ye do good to them which do good to you, what thank have ye? for sinners also do even the same. And if ye lend to them of whom ye hope to receive, what thank have ye? for sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again. But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and to the evil. Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful. Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven: Luke 6:27-28,31-37*

God is a righteous Judge but it also not His will that any would perish but that all would come to repentance. If we repent the Lord forgives. If He has forgiven so much He expects His children to forgive.

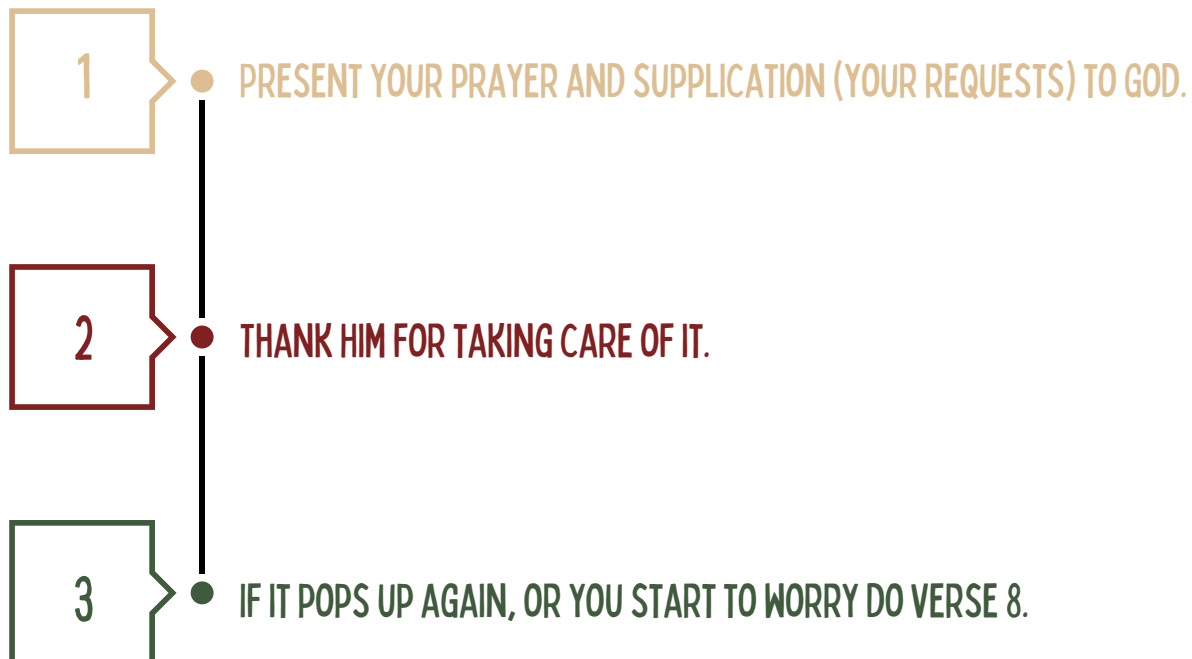
